# hamish kippen

**Month-long Gallery Exhibit and Book Featuring  
his Photographs in October 2009**

Hamish Kippen was born in Belfast, Northern Ireland, on May 17, 1987. He died in Toronto on October 21, 2008, at the age of 21. His loss is deeply felt by family, friends and the arts community. To honour his artistic legacy, a gallery exhibit created by Simone Otis, Ryan Greenwood, McKenzie James, Jefre Nicholls and curated by Peter Miniaci, will be on display throughout the month of October. A book featuring his beautiful work, designed by all of his family and friends and produced by Andrew Croft of INHOUSE Productions, will be published this fall and launched with the exhibition.

Part of the proceeds from the book will be donated to DAREarts ([www.darearts.com](http://www.darearts.com)), which stands for Discipline, Action, and Responsibility in Education and was founded to help Canadian children find positive alternatives to negative influences in their communities through a five-year arts education program that complements Canadian elementary schools.

The Kippen family is also pleased to announce The Hamish Kippen Excellence in Arts Award, kindly established by Anne-Marie and Duncan Brinsmead. The award will be granted to eligible students demonstrating outstanding work in the Visual Arts and Humanities at The Chang School, Ryerson University.
